Test description

Audition and interview:

The video audition consists of a program with music of your choice where improvisation is a natural part of the performance. This program must be no more than 20 minutes long.

After that you will be called for an interview with the jury which will take place in week 11 using Skype/Zoom or a similar digital platform.

Duration of the test: approximately 30 minutes (performance + interview).

Please note!

In connection with the web application, you must upload a text (2 pages, A4 format, pdf) where you clearly describe what you wish to develop and focus on with your studies, including a preliminary idea for the degree project (which forms a large part of the program). Also, present briefly about your artistic orientation, as well as how previous experiences and / or studies are relevant to be able to complete a degree project of a larger scale. This presentation is an important part of your application, so that we can assess your possibilities to complete the program. The objectives for the Master's degree include, among other things, being able to reflect on artistic processes in general and one's own working methods in particular, as well as on artistic questions in dialogue with the music world and with the society.

This presentation is sent to KMH using the same link for uploading your video audition.

Instructions and criteria for making video auditions

Please use the following instructions when making your video auditions:

- A link for uploading files will be sent to the email address you used when submitting your application on universityadmissions.se. The deadline for uploading files is **February 25, 2022**.
- Please read the test description thoroughly to ensure exactly how many pieces/songs/presentations you should upload.
- Please start your video by showing your ID and a close-up of your face. Continue by stating what piece you will be performing and for which test/programme. Your face and hands should be visible throughout the whole performance.
- Please perform only one piece per video clip. No post-production or editing is allowed.
- Make sure the audio sounds good. You are allowed to use the sound from a room microphone or the microphone from your phone. The sound should be without distortion or white noise, and not too much room acoustics.
- Make sure the focus and lighting of your camera are good.
- The recordings are to be uploaded to KMH. You are allowed to use the following file formats: MP4 or MOV.

If these criteria are not met or the jury finds your video audition modified, you might fail the test.
